

WHAT TO BRING

We recommend bringing:

- warm clothes for the evening
 - a flashlight or headlamp
 - lights, lanterns, or small decorative lighting
(including colorful and atmospheric lights) to help create a beautiful evening atmosphere
 - a sleeping mat / yoga mat and sleeping bag
 - swimwear
 - your own cup or water bottle
 - a good mood and an open heart
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ARRIVAL & ACCREDITATION

The festival gates open on Thursday from 13:00.

Accreditation is located near Hotel Polianka
(zone no. 10 on the map).

Here you will exchange your digital ticket for a festival wristband and report your parking or camping type.

Please do not forget to bring:

- digital ticket
- ID card / passport

The festival wristband is non-transferable.

PARKING & CAMPING

After registration, you will be guided to your designated area according to your parking or accommodation type. Payments for parking and camping are made on-site during accreditation.

CAMPING

5 € / person – full festival

PARKING – personal car

10 € – full festival

PARKING + TENT

20 € – full festival

CARAVAN PARKING

20 € – full festival

FESTIVAL RULES
